Background:

On March 24, 1959, the governments of Canada and New Brunswick by agreement established the Saint John River Basin Board. The Board's terms of reference stated that it was to "plan, supervise and carry out an investigation to determine how the present and future power developments in New Brunswick would be affected by the development and operation of storage on the upper Saint John River and its tributaries." At that time the main concern was the proposed Passamaquoddy-Saint John River development; the possibility of tidal power; and the effects of power developments on other potential water uses of the river. Board members included staff from the Water Resources Branch of the federal government, and from the New Brunswick Electric Power Commission.

The Federal/Provincial Saint John River Basin Board was to consist of six members at a senior level, three appointed by Canada and three appointed by New Brunswick. The provincial members were J.C. Smith (vice-chair), F.C. MacLoon, and R.B.B. Dickison, and the federal members were E. Roy Tinney (chair), J.P. Parkinson, and R.R. McIntyre.

The Board appointed a Planning Director who supervised the planning office and a small group of federal employees, as well as the work of consultants under contract.

The first meeting of the Board took place in March, 1959. In September of 1960 the Board presented its report to the two governments. The report was entitled "Effects of Storage on Power Generation in New Brunswick". It emphasized the importance of multipurpose development of the river and provided a detailed study of the consequence and economics of complete development. The report was not publicly released until 1964, in response to discussions between Canada and the U.S. on the Passamaquoddy Tidal Power and the Dickey Storage and Power projects.

The Maritime Provinces Water Resources Study (1969) commissioned by the Atlantic Development Board showed the St. John River had major water quality and management problems requiring immediate action. A federal/provincial agreement signed June 30, 1970 initiated comprehensive planning of the water resources of the basin. Pollution was seen as the most immediate problem of the basin's water resource. A dual program was specified, consisting of planning for water quality and for the optimum use of available water.

Scope and Content:

The series comprises minutes of meetings, reports, studies, summaries, guidelines, working papers, press releases and news clippings, correspondence, and records concerning the Mactaquac Dam Project, the Lorneville proposed development, and the Green River project (among others). The records document decisions made and action taken to improve the basin's water resource. Also included is correspondence to and from the N.B. Water Resources Board, the New Brunswick Electric Power Commission, and various Canadian and U.S. federal departments and agencies.

In large part the records maintain the arrangement assigned by the Board. Note that the records have been arranged and described in two parts to reflect their original order. It is clear that the Board created and maintained the records separately for the periods 1959 to 1965 and 1970 to 1975. The index to the finding aid (not the actual documents) has been provided to assist research. All names and subjects have been indexed. The capitalized and bold faced terms in the index are to sub-series for that topic.

Researchers should note that there are other sources of information on the activities of the Board. The New Brunswick Legislative Library holds an extensive number of publications and reports produced by the Board, which supplement the reports found in this record series. Additionally, other series of records from the Department of the Environment contain files relating to the work of the Board as do records of the premiers and various other departments and officials with whom the Board interacted.

Acquisition:

The Provincial Archives received these records in three transfers. The bulk of the records (34 boxes) were accessioned in 1977 as R1977.40, two more boxes of mainly Mactaquac development records were accessioned as R1978.19, and two volumes of minutes were received from Department of Environment as R1994.119.
